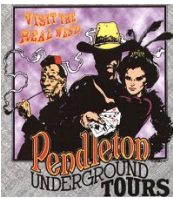

Future of Flight Aviation Center, Boeing Tour & Flying Heritage Collection June 17

As you enter the Future of Flight, you overlook the Grand Lobby and Main Exhibit Gallery. Gaze up at the futuristic-looking aircraft "soaring" overhead against a backdrop of clouds. Look down at the 200-foot-long runway painted onto the floor of the gallery. At the runway's end is the nose section of a Boeing 727 positioned as if it's taking off. The Boeing Everett factory tours are conducted to showcase the Boeing Company and the Everett product line, the 747, 767, 777, & 787. A part of the tour visitors walk through part of the largest building in the world by volume (472,000,000 cubic feet). On the Boeing Flight line visitors see airplanes in various stages of assembly, manufactured and flight test for airline customers around the world. We will then have our lunch and upon completion of lunch overlooking Elliott Bay we will then head to the Flying Heritage Collection. The planes within the Flying Heritage Collection were created as a time when aeronautical discovery had evolved to aviation mastery. Finely crafted by distinguished design bureaus with leading technologies of the 1930's and 1940's the main emphasis of the collection includes combat aircraft from World War II.

No Refunds can be made for cancellations LESS than (7) days PRIOR to departure.

Day Trips: All day trips require 50% deposit of the individual tour cost. Full and Final Balance must be made a minimum of 30 days prior. Tours canceled less than 30 days prior will be assessed a \$15 per person service fee plus the cost of pre-purchased ticket, admissions and or guaranteed services. No Refunds can be made for cancellations LESS than (7) days PRIOR to departure
