## How much does it cost to ride the bus?

	One-way fare	Monthly passes
Adults (age 18 and over) .....	75¢ .....	\$17.00
Youths (age 6 - 17) .....	50¢ .....	\$12.00
Reduced Fare (Persons 62/over, people with disabilities & Medicare Card holders. Reduced Fare ID card required for reduced fare.) .....	35¢ .....	\$ 5.00
Pre-School (under 6, accompanied by adult) .....	FREE	
Transfers (See Transfer policy, page 6) .....	FREE	

Yakima Transit drivers do not make change, so have the exact fare ready.

## Page Accessible Service



Almost all of Yakima Transit's buses 'kneel' to the ground to accommodate walkers and those who have difficulty climbing stairs. All Yakima Transit routes are designated as "Accessible" and have lift-equipped buses to accommodate our passengers using mobility devices, such as wheelchairs.

## Where are the Bus Stops?

Yakima Transit has over 800 bus stops located throughout the cities of Yakima and Selah. Generally, these bus stops are located about every two blocks along each bus route. Each bus stop is marked by a "Yakima Transit Bus Stop" sign. If you don't know where to find the closest bus stop to your location, call Yakima Transit. We will be happy to help you locate the closest one.

Call Yakima Transit at **575-6175** and tell them where you are, where you want to go, and when you want to arrive. They'll give you the information you need to reach your destination.

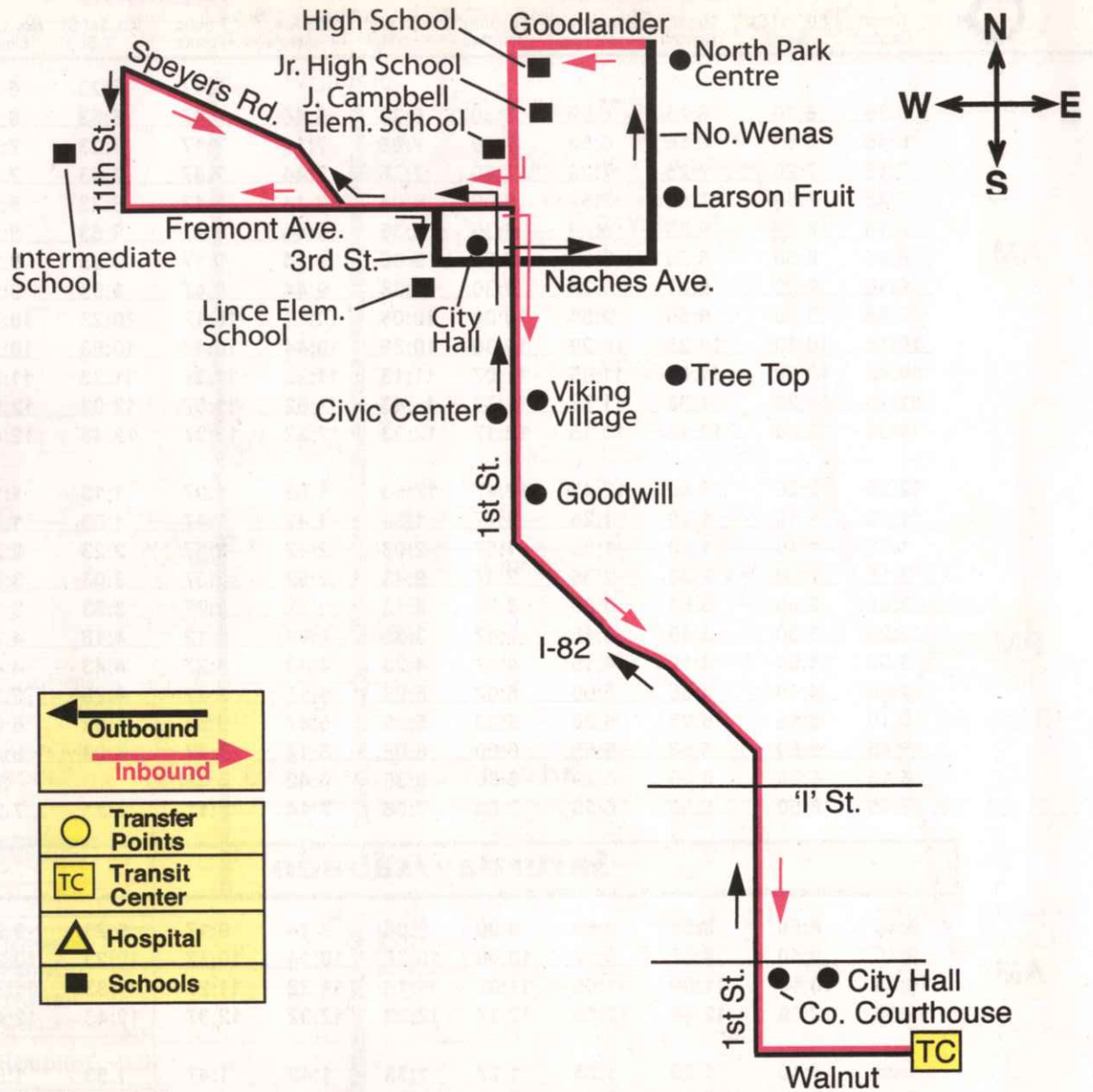
